

Demonstration Project to Measure Residual Cadmium in Food and Water in China

The Food Safety Act was enforced in China in 2009, and heavy metal inspections of food is being carried out by the public health and administration departments in provinces, autonomous regions, and municipalities.

High precision analytical equipment is already in use by provincial organizations, however, observance of the law has not been put into practice due to a shortage of engineers.

A demonstration project is being carried out on cadmium at five research and inspection organizations in Beijing in order to expand the use of and sell simple analysis kits.
